



To whom it may concern:

The Sherman Volunteer Fire Department is an all volunteer agency providing fire and medical emergency services for the town of Sherman. The fire station is located at:

Sherman, CT 06784

Our apparatus provide a 5000 gallon initial water supply with automatic mutual aid for any reported structure fire. Mutual aid companies bring an additional 4000 gallons on the first alarm.

There are no pressurized hydrants within the town of Sherman. Water is obtained from various locations around town including dry hydrants, ponds, pools and Candlewood Lake. A link on that page will take you to a google map which you can use to determine the distance from those water sources to an address within Sherman.
